THE OTHERS CAN AND SHOULD BE COMMUNITY MEMBERS, INCLUDING FORMER PATIENTS WHO HAVE EXPRESSED AN ACTIVE INTEREST IN THE CARE OF PERSONS WHO ARE MENTALLY DISABLED. RETIREES (AT LEAST 2 YEARS POST RETIREMENT) WHO HAVE SUCH INTEREST CAN ALSO APPLY.

ALL SELECTED MEMBERS MUST GO THROUGH THE SENATE REVIEW PROCESS.
